Proclamation

WHEREAS, South Texas, including Laguna Vista, is a vital breeding ground for the monarch butterfly generation traveling to Mexico; and

WHEREAS, cities, towns, and counties have a critical role to play in helping to save the monarch butterfly; and

WHEREAS, every citizen of the Town of Laguna Vista can make a difference for the monarch by planting native milkweed and nectar plants to provide habitat for both the monarch and other pollinators in locations where people live, work, learn, play, and worship.
