PRESENTATION – Presentation from Art Trainor on Pickle Ball Courts. (General Manager)

Presentation from Art Trainor about pickle ball.

Mr. Trainor gave a brief history of the sport pickle ball. He was requesting the CDC approve the construction / placement of three pickle ball courts in Roloff Park. They are requesting concrete court in the area of a 60x94 (basketball court size). The current basketball court has taped off lines for the pickle ball court; however, the zuba class tends to disrupt the tape when they dance.

It was noted that the CDC does not have the authority to authorize or approve the request made by Mr. Trainor. This request and decision needs to be taken up thrugh the Town Council and included in the City's Park Master Plan.

As an alternative it was agreed that the City would PAINT the court lines on the basketball court which would eliminate the tape being pulled up with the Zumba dancing.
